

Hello from the Town Clerk's Office!

2020 is shaping up to be a very busy year, starting with the Local and Federal Census. The Local Census is already on its way to your homes. Please remember to make any necessary changes and return it to the Clerk's Office when it is complete. The Federal Census will be mailed to your homes separately from the Local Census. Please fill this out also and return it, abiding by the instructions included. The Federal Census is very important as the data collected is used to determine the number of seats each state has in the U.S. House of Representatives and is used to draw boundaries for congressional and state legislative districts. This Data is also used to distribute federal funds.

We will be having a very busy Election Season this year! Nomination papers will be available at the Clerk's Office January 15, 2020 for our Local Election, which is held on the first Monday in May each year. This year the local election is Monday, May 4, 2020 and the polling location is the Merrimac Public Library located at 86 West Main Street, Merrimac.

Our Annual Town Meeting, will take place on April 27, 2020. Town Meetings are held at the Dr. Fredrick N. Sweetsir School on Church Street at 7:30pm. If necessary, we will also have a Special Town Meeting in the fall at the Sweetsir School.

Super Tuesday is March 3, 2020 and voting will take place at the Merrimac Public Library, 86 West Main Street from 7am-8pm. Early Voting for this election will take place for one week, February 24-28, at Sargent Hall, Merrimac Town Hall 2 School Street. Hours for Early Voting are as follows: Monday 9am – 7pm, Tuesday – Friday 9am-4pm.

The State Primary will be Tuesday, September 1, 2020 and voting will take place at the Merrimac Public Library, 86 West Main Street 7am-8pm. There is No Early Voting for this election.

The November Election will be Tuesday, November 3, 2020 and voting will take place at the Merrimac Public Library, 86 West Main Street 7am-8pm. Early Voting for this election will take place for two weeks, October 19 – October 30, at Sargent Hall, Merrimac Town Hall 2 School Street. Hours for Early Voting are as follows: Mondays 9am – 7pm, Tuesdays – Fridays 9am-4pm and Saturday 9am - noon.

Your election workers and my staff have been attending several training sessions to enhance our services to you this voting season. We encourage you to keep the included flyer as a reminder of election dates and activities for this busy year!
