## **ABATEMENTS TAKE 4-6 WEEKS TO PROCESS**

Per MA State law, you are **not** entitled to an abatement if you:

- 1. Retain ownership of the vehicle
- 2. Move to another MA city or town, during the same calendar year
- 3. No abatement or refund of less than \$5.00 may be made

## MA STATE LAW requires you must provide the following documents with your application:

**SOLD**: Bill of Sale AND Registration Cancellation Receipt from RMV

**TRADED**: Trade in receipt AND Copy of New Registration from RMV

**STOLEN:** Police report AND Registration Cancellation Receipt from RMV

<u>TOTAL LOSS</u>: Insurance Letter (must include year, make & model of vehicle) <u>AND</u> Registration Cancellation Receipt from RMV

REPOSSESSED: Notice from lienholder AND Registration Cancellation Receipt from RMV

<u>JUNKED OR DONATED:</u> Receipt from Junk Yard or Charity (must include year, make & model of vehicle) <u>AND</u> Registration Cancellation Receipt

**MOVED FROM MA:** Copy of Registration from New State <u>AND</u> Registration Cancellation Receipt from RMV

**OVERVALUED**: Must show proof of overvaluation (MSRP from dealership AND Bill of Sale)

**EXEMPTION**: Documentation establishing qualifications

**LEASED VEHICLES**: If your vehicle is leased, the leasing company (as owner) is responsible for applying for the abatement. Please contact your leasing company.
