oil-based paints (not latex paint),  
varnishes, pesticides, pool  
chemicals, gasoline, and other  
household hazardous chemicals.

Residents should expect to be  
charged by the size of the container,  
not the approximation of the  
chemicals remaining in the container.  
Cash and checks (payable to the  
Town of Merrimac) will be accepted.  
**No credit cards.**

### Do NOT Bring:

- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
- Asbestos
- Commercial hazardous waste
- Construction waste/building materials
- CRT's, CPU's, computer monitors, TV sets
- Empty aerosol cans
- Fire extinguishers
- Gas cylinders (other than propane)\*
- Infectious or biological wastes
- Latex Paint
- Medicines or syringes
- PCB's
- Radioactive materials
- Smoke detectors
- Tires
